Love Thy Neighbor As Thyself.....

In Matthew 22:37-40, Jesus gives us the two greatest commandments. We are to love God with all our heart, soul and mind and we are to love our neighbor as ourselves. He goes on to tell us that the law and the prophets depend on these two commandments! So, like me, have you ever wondered what this truly means? If they are the greatest commandments, then we best know their meaning fully!

Volumes have been written about love; many of them about loving God. From every pulpit this sermon is preached. The love required is all consuming and passionate. It engages us completely...heart, soul & mind. A genuine love for God will produce in us a love for our neighbor. So, who exactly is our neighbor? It is **any**one we come in contact with! We have the 'who', now let's look at the how. Jesus said to love them as we love ourselves. There is a love that is corrupt and is the root of all the greatest sins of man and it must be crucified and put off as a filthy garment. But there is also a love that's natural that must be preserved and sanctified. It is a God given respect for the dignity of our own natures created in His image and a serious concern for the welfare of our own souls and nature. We're commanded to love and esteem <u>all</u> men, to wrong or injure <u>no</u> one. We're to have good will and wishes toward <u>all</u> and as the opportunities arise-do good to <u>all</u>.

We are to pursue the physical health and spiritual well being of our neighbors with the very same intensity and concern that we do so for ourselves. We're to love as truly and sincerely as we do ourselves. In many cases, we will need to deny ourselves for the good of our neighbor. We are to make ourselves servants to the true welfare of others and be willing to spend and be spent for them. We lay our lives down for the glory of God. A believer's entire life provides a unique privilege by which we can serve others in Christ's name. It's the primary test of our love for God (Gal. 6:10).

So, how serious is this? Christ said that all the Law and the Prophets hang on this. It's the sum & substance of all the precepts that relate to a practical religion. **EVERYTHING** hangs on the law of love! If it's taken away, it falls and we are nothing more than a clanging gong. Love animates and cements the law. It is a comprehensive summary of the entire Bible. It's the root and spring of all other duties. Love is the fruit of faith...that we love God in Christ and our neighbor for His sake. The fulfillment of the law is love (Rom 13:10), and the end of the law is love (1Tim.1:5). This love will never fail. Love is the nail on which hangs all the glory of the law and the prophets (Isa.22:24) which will never be drawn out, for on this nail eternally hangs all the glory of the New Jerusalem! Hallelujah!

In obeying these two commandments and genuinely loving others, we fulfill all the moral requirements of the Mosaic Law concerning them. This is the ruling principal of Christian freedom. Pure and undefiled religion in the sight of God will reveal a holy life and a charitable loving heart (James 1:27). It is seen in acts that minister to the needs of the poor and afflicted among us...our neighbors. Also, it's revealed by our remaining pure and unstained by the world. This was demonstrated perfectly by Jesus' life here on Earth and is the goal that has been set before us. Jesus is to be revealed through us and we are to be known for the love that we have for others. As we determine in our hearts to obey, we can step out in faith and know that He will empower and equip us to accomplish all that He asks.

Who is our neighbor?

This month I had a walk in person I'll name Mary to protect her privacy, who came in to Love's Treasury Christian Bookstore. Mary had been out walking and saw our sign and thought it might be a good place for a rest. You wouldn't know it by appearance but Mary is homeless in Puyallup. We struck up quite a conversation about her situation, on her side of the conversation, and how she is one of the statistics so to speak of homeless who are hard to help, so she doesn't get much assistance through housing programs or agencies. She has a lot of medical issues, is extremely sensitive to smells, fragrances, animals, etc to where it makes her ill. Mary is in her early 60's and had a thriving landscape business till all these medical issues came to light and she couldn't work with the plants anymore. She lost her company. She can only eat liquids during the day she said, and has found she can get steamed milk at Starbucks. She's been living in her car for the past couple years and occasionally would drive to her sister's in Oregon and she would pay her some money for helping her around her house, but she can't stay there because her sister has a lot of pets and being around them makes Mary ill. Right now Mary can't drive anywhere. Her engine went out on her car. She said she has found someone in Lakewood who could fix it for about \$1000.00 She said the YMCA gave her a membership so she could shower there, and they gave her a bus pass so she can ride the bus to a restaurant in Lakewood that feeds her dinner each evening. She said maybe in a year or two she can get back into an apartment. She has all her belongings in storage but doesn't want to try to sell them, in hopes she'll have that apartment one day. Judy in our clearinghouse center needs volunteers to help with data entry of client info into our online database that the churches have access to.



I don't have all the information needed yet to see if we can find help for Mary. I did do a little research around town with groups that help the homeless to see if I could find out more of Mary's story. Before she left the store that day, one of the volunteers felt God nudging her to give Mary some money, though Mary didn't ask for it. Mary prayed with the volunteer thanking God for the help from this lady.

Mary said she was staying in the Walmart parking lot. I tried to drive it this morning to see if I could locate her car. I didn't know what the car looked like, but figured I'd give it a shot. I saw three homeless folks auto's at the parking lot, early in the morning, two had towels covering the windows to keep the sun and onlookers out. One of the cars had a dog tied to the door handle.

I'd like to see if somehow the networking we do could help Mary get an apartment that she could afford. I don't know what her income is yet, but she mentioned she gets some sort of disability check, that was different from Social Security Disability. That is under \$700 a month. I'd like to see if a group of churches would help with the expense of getting her engine fixed, or have mechanics who could donate their time and we get funds donated to cover the parts. I'm thankful the YMCA has done so much to help her. Mary falls in the gap of most agencies because it's nearly impossible to help someone with so many issues, and no children.

Her allergies and sensitivities limit where she can stay and who she can be around. She told me she doesn't take drugs and doesn't drink. Earlier in her life she said she was an alcoholic but that was long ago.

It's quite a walk from the Walmart to our store. I believe Mary will be back and I'd like to try to offer her more hope for her tomorrows. When I asked God, what could I do to help Mary, I felt impressed upon my heart, to do what I know to do and trust God for the rest....so I am writing and getting the need out there and waiting in faith that people will rally together to do what each of them can do too.
